From the Costume Chair (Kim Wellschlager):

Costume Bins:

Please send your cast member in with their bin to rehearsal on <u>Saturday, February 29th</u> (if you have a conflict that day or are not called please bring in the next available rehearsal). You can find a sample bin by clicking on the link <u>here</u>. You can get these at Target, Walmart, Home Depot, etc. It does not need to be new in case you already have one lying around the house, but please make sure it is large enough to hold undergarments, shoes, makeup items and costume accessories and also street clothes when cast members are wearing their costumes. Label your cast member's name on all sides -- they can go straight back to the music/chorus room.

<u>Undergarments</u>: All female cast members will need a nude leotard or nude cami and dance/bike shorts. All male cast members will need black compression shorts and a black or white tank top. These items are required to be worn under all costumes.

Footwear:

<u>Police</u>: black shoes, such as a black jazz shoe or all black sneaker.

<u>Daughters</u>: For 2nd Act, nude jazz shoes or ballet shoe. For 1st Act, more specifics to come as we continue fitting kids in costumes. Most likely brown boots, however a jazz shoe may also work.

<u>Pirates</u>: More specifics to come as we continue fitting kids in costumes. Most likely black shoes to wear boot covers over or black boots.

*Additional characters not yet named will receive further direction as we continue to fit kids.
