Pirate Post #2 Settling In, Chaperone Sign-Ups and More

Hello Cast Parents,

Please read to the end – they won't always be this lengthy!

First Rehearsal: As I'm sure you have heard, by all accounts the all-cast read through last Wednesday was fabulous. The musicality of these kids is incredible! Mrs. Metcalfe and Mr. Dave lead the cast in a few ice breakers and drama games before getting started. Photos were posted on our <u>facebook page</u>. Everyone in the cast received a script and they should all have their names written in them and all markings *in pencil*. They will be collected up at the end of the run, with markings erased.

Weekly Rehearsal Call List: The first weekly rehearsal call list email went out quite late on Sunday/early Monday (!). It should come out in the early afternoon going forward. A printable version is also posted on our website at spmssings.org on the password-protected cast information page. This is a wacky week with two early rehearsals on Tuesday and Wednesday and no rehearsal on Thursday. We plan to update this each week. As a reminder, the password is leapyear, all lowercase.

Cast Contact List: The cast contact list is now posted on the cast info page on the website <u>here</u>. Feel free to reach out to other parents for carpooling, etc.

Rehearsal Reminders:

- Cast members must sign in on the attendance sheet near the chorus room door. You do not need to sign out.
- Bring your script, every time!
- Bring a snack but consume it in the hall, please. Only water is allowed in the chorus room.
- Please wear attire appropriate you can move in. Closed toed shoes required on choreo days.
- Large groups of students will be dismissed out the *front door*.
- Parents, thank you for waiting outside the building for your student. Please arrive to pick up your student on-time. Mrs. Metcalfe wants to go home too!

Saturday Rehearsals: As we start Saturday rehearsals, please remember to bring a lunch if you will be at school through the noon timeframe. If you are being dismissed at noon you don't need to bring a lunch. Please enter and exit through the M Hall door. No one is to leave the school building for any reason unless they are dismissed.

Rehearsal Tracks: Rehearsal music tracks (both with vocals and without) can be found on google classroom. The code is: snq32ga. Your student should access these tracks and download the ones they are performing.

Chaperones: We need 3 more chaperones for coverage <u>for this week</u>, plus there are a lot of open slots in the coming weeks. Click <u>here</u> to sign up. Reminder: each family is <u>required</u> to sign up for two sessions – thank you for making the commitment today...Chaperone guidance is on the sign-up sheet. A copy of the guidance is also available in the attendance binder in the chorus room. It's easy and fun. Note: You do **not** need a background check to chaperone at rehearsals. Thank you, Nancy Todd, for chaperoning last week.

Committee Sign Ups: We are in very good shape with staffing the 19 committees at this point. Thank you for signing up at the parent meeting. However, there are a few committees that still could use a few more volunteers. They are given here in order of priority (click here for descriptions):

- 1) Group ticket sales (1 position open)
- 2) Publicity (1-2 positions open, people to hang posters)
- 3) Set Construction (2 positions open please folks who know how to use a screw gun!)
- 4) Set Decoration (Painting) (2 positions open)
- 5) Hair & Makeup (3 positions open, teens welcome)
- 6) Door Security (1 position open, teen welcome)

Families who have not yet signed up for a committee should have received a separate communication. Reminder: serving on a committee is <u>required</u> for your child's participation in the show. Plus, it's fun!

Committee Chairs: All of the committee chairs were sent a welcome email regarding committee member contact information, budget, and some general guidelines. The list of committee leads with contact info is posted here. I have started setting up small group production meetings so you will hear form me very soon.

Commitment Contracts and Fees: We had a very high rate of signed cast commitment contracts and fee payments being made on time! Thank you so much. There are a few families who have not turned in their cast commitment contracts and/or cast fees. You will be contacted by a separate email to make arrangements. Failure to complete this step will unfortunately cause your student to lose their role in the production. We don't want that to happen!

Cast Bonding / Open Mic Night: This is a shameless plug to get the cast to attend or participate in Open Mic Night, set for Friday, Feb 7th in the cafeteria from 7-9 pm.
