Peach Buzz #9 - Costume Pieces Needed, Tech Meals, and More!

Hello Cast Parents,

Here's the juicy information for the week. I'll keep this as short as possible:

Important Items:

- 1. **Cast Head Shots:** Gina took head shots on Sunday. Many cast members were not prepared, but the show must go on, so the photos that were taken will be on the show board. For anyone who missed photos due to a conflict on their conflict calendar, Gina will be at rehearsal on Wednesday to take photos. Those cast members should wear a solid colored top with no visible logos or prints.
- 2. **Costumes:** Notes from the costume chair. If you have any costume questions, please email kwellsch@gmail.com.
 - a. We're looking for smaller size (boys and girls size 14-16) button down shirts (preferably white, not blue) to borrow.
 - b. Also, boys' size 14-16 pants either khaki, back or navy.
 - c. If your child has indicated that we've requested them to bring in a shirt or pants, we are not requesting you buy these items but rather, if you already have them, if they can be worn by your child in the show. With many of the cast members requiring three distinct looks we are trying to fit everyone with our current inventory and items we've procured. We also know that sometimes a cast members' own items may be the most comfortable for specific characters, as long as they fit the costuming guidelines. If your child has already brought in a requested item from home, thank you for your support! Labeling the inside with masking tape and their name will help ensure the items get properly returned.
 - d. For shoes we still request cast members wear black or nude jazz shoes or black speakers.
 - e. Undergarments for girls are nude leotards or nude cami with nude dance/bike shorts and for boys an undershirt and black compression shorts.
 - f. Specifically, for the puppeteers, black long-sleeved shirts, black pants and black shoes/sneakers are required. Please bring these items in from home but if you need help getting any of these items, please let us know.
 - g. The costume parade is this Saturday, March 16th. For that process we will ask each cast member by number to get in costume and go out onto the stage to have all costume looks approved by the director. This will also help the costume team know what final items or changes we need to make prior to tech week dress rehearsals.
- 3. **Tech Week Meals:** Please order your tech week meals here or through the cast information page at spmssings.org. The deadline for ordering is 8 pm **Wednesday, Mar 20th**. You can choose to buy the meals (1, 2, or all 3 days) at \$7.50 each or you can bring dinner from home. The menu is:
